CHURCH UPDATE: Scaffolding and netting up at last, which means we can use the entrance safely again. Next step will be an up-close structural assessment followed by recommendations for repairs. Then we have to put out to tender and receive quotes before submitting an insurance claim. We can't start any repairs until we've heard from the insurers. We're probably looking at October for completing the repairs at the earliest. **In the meantime, please be careful entering and exiting the church: steel poles hurt!** You may also have noticed ongoing renovations to both the hall and sacristy. These should be completed in the next couple of weeks. The hall improvements will provide Lizzie with a much safer space in which to work. The sacristy area has been opened up by removing the partition in the middle. A pieced screen will be erected to separate the sacristy area from the side entry way. This will make it clear that the sacristy is not a public space, but without compromising our safeguarding regime.

FR BILL: Is rather washed-out after everything happening these last few weeks and so will be lying low for a few days. Consequently there will be no weekday Masses this week. Sorry for any inconvenience.

GIVING BY CARD: Our new card machine is now in place. It is really simple to use: just press the amount you'd like to give and tap your card. Please don't worry about *GiftAid* at the moment because that will require entering all your details. Perhaps do that mid-week when there is no queue. All parishes who have this system report that it pays for itself in the first month, so we can't lose and have everything to gain. We get lots of casual visitors during the week while the church is open. Now they have an opportunity to contribute to the running of the parish and our stunning little church.

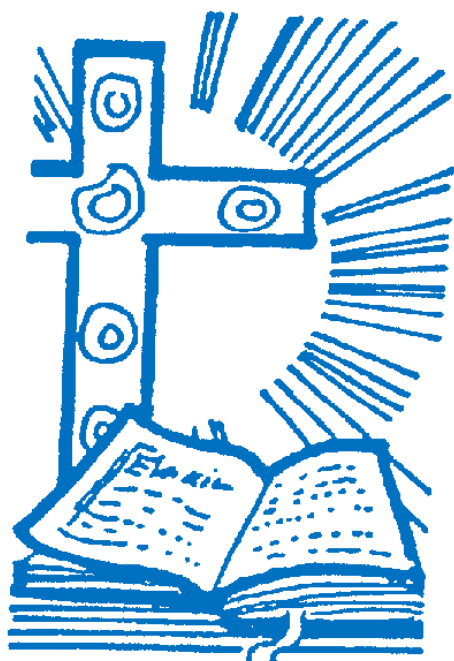
