Regular Massgoers shouldn't really need to use them because they just contain the texts we use every Sunday, along with any variants. So, for instance, on the front panel you will see all three options for the priest's greeting:

- The grace of OR
- Grace to you OR
- The Lord be with you

all of which have the same response: And with your spirit.

Underneath that, we have the Penitential Act, of which there are 3 forms:

- I confess OR
- Have mercy on us, O Lord..... OR
- You were sent..... OR

So if we don't begin with "I confess...." TURN OVER!

The rest of the card is self explanatory: please just follow through if you need to.

PLEASE LEAVE THE ORDER OF MASS CARD IN YOUR PEW. THANKS.

ANTIPHONS, PSALM RESPONSES, GOSPEL

ACCLAMATION VERSES: These change every week. To help you, we have reproduced them in a leaflet that lasts 6 weeks (14th Sunday—today— to 19th Sunday of the year—August 13th). Each Sunday has its own panel. Again, please leave in your pew. Note to readers: if there are any optional texts, the leaflet will offer the first one.

READERS: Obviously, it is now especially important that we can hear and understand what you are saying. Please make a special effort to proclaim the readings clearly and slowly, observing the punctuation carefully. Please do not rush or read to

yourself: communicate! Remember, you are reading the *Word of God, the Message of Eternal Life*.
