

CHRISTIAN UNITY WEEK: Began on Thursday. We pray for all the families of Christianity in the expectation of eventual unity.

TONY THORPE: We are sorry to tell you that Tony died in the early hours of Wednesday in his sleep. Tony was a dedicated and well-loved parishioner at OLOL. We offer our prayers for him and his family, especially Pauline, at this time. We are asked to respect their privacy for the time being. Tony's Funeral Mass will be offered on Friday 9th February with a Vigil the afternoon before, times to be confirmed. May he rest in peace.

FR BILL: Please note, Fr Bill is not available this week. There will be no weekday Masses. Please welcome Fr Bernie Luna, a Mill Hill Missionary, who will be offering Masses next weekend. Fr Luna will be raising our awareness of the Red Box Appeal, but will not be asking for donations.

CRIB COLLECTION: The crib will remain in the church until 2nd February. Any offerings will be in aid of the Christian Communities of the Holy Land via the organization, Friends of the Holy Land.

FIRE DRILL: Please be aware that there will be practice drills in the near future. When you hear the words "FIRE! FIRE! FIRE!" you must evacuate the building(s) in an orderly fashion using both exits. The following protocols apply, namely:

- Infirm persons should remain in their seats until a steward arrives to safely escort them out
- Do not stop at any exit for any reason
- Head straight to the correct muster station
- Do not leave the grounds unless it is dangerous to stay; we need to account for everybody
- Do not re-enter building(s) for any reason, until instructed to do so

SEVERE WEATHER PLAN; We need gritters to lay down salt in the church grounds when it is icy. Can you help? You would need to check the forecast on Saturdays and do the gritting on Saturday afternoon if ice/snow is probable. Please contact the parish office if you are willing to do this for us. Thanks.

TORCHES: We need to keep everyone safe before and after Saturday evening Masses. Alex and Roy have been doing a great job holding our superpowerful torches front and rear of the church. Can you lighten the load by giving them a night off? If so, please come early (5.20pm) and see Fr. Bill or Roy. Thanks.
