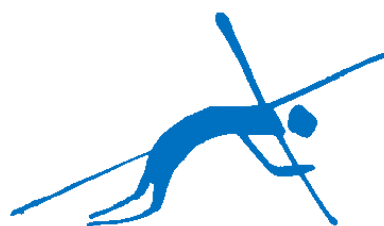
GOOD FRIDAY CELEBRATION OF THE
