**PLEASE NOTE:** Fr Bill is having some down time this week at home. There are no Masses Monday-Wednesday this week. Please try not to disturb him for these few days. Thanks.

**VOTIVE CANDLES:** Our votive candles are very popular, especially after Sunday Mass. However, it is most important that we use them safely. Please only place candles in the individual sockets on the stands. On no account balance candles on top of others or place on the sand below. This is very dangerous and will certainly invalidate our insurance should anything untoward happen. If there are no candle sockets left, why not come during the week instead? The church is usually open every day from about 8.00am until 4.00pm/5.00pm. We really need to keep safety a priority. If you notice anyone not observing the proper procedure, please ask them not to or let Fr. Bill know asap. Children should not light candles unattended. Candles & Children don't mix! Our co-operation in this matter is both appreciated and required.
