

TODAY'S GOSPEL THIS IS INTOLERABLE LANGUAGE: MANY DISCIPLES LEFT JESUS

TODAY'S GOSPEL EVENT: Is known as the "Galilean Crisis". "Crisis" is derived from the Greek words "krinein" and "kritike" from which we get the words "critic" and "criterion". "Crisis" means a judgement, a decisive decision, or a parting at a crossroads, which is just what we see in today's Gospel. Jesus' followers judge his words to be intolerable; they make a decisive decision to leave; they part ways with Jesus and "stopped going with him." This episode is all the more strange because Jesus has the crowd eating out of his hand one minute, and repelling it the next. As Christians were are very used to the Eucharistic language of "eating my flesh", but what must it have sounded like to the crowd? Was the Galilean Crisis a failure or a success, do you think?


25TH AUGUST 2024 21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, YEAR B
