Ever more, by your Spirit you move human hearts that enemies may speak to each other again, adversaries join hands, and peoples seek to meet together.


By the working of your power it comes about, O Lord, that hatred is overcome by love, revenge gives way to forgiveness, and discord is changed to mutual respect.

PRISONERS' SUNDAY: TODAY. Our prisons are in crisis and life for prisoners and their families in our communities is challenging. PACT, The national Catholic prisoners charity supports prisoners, their spouses/partners, and their children, offering them hope and the chance to turn their lives around. Last year, PACT staff and volunteers supported more than 485,000 prison visits, assisted more than 36,000 family members, and helped over 408 people with emergency welfare grants.
