CONFLICT IN THE NEAR/MIDDLE EAST: As

anger and violence continue to spiral out of control on all sides, we pray that the Holy Spirit will guide diplomatic efforts and soften the hearts of those who are given over to rage and vengeance, whatever the reason. We pray also for those civilians whose lives have been benighted with violence, and those who are working to provide medical and other forms of humanitarian aid in extremely hazardous conditions. Here is an extract from our *Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation II* that we might like to pray each day:

For though the human race is divided by dissension and discord, yet we know that by testing us you change our hearts to prepare them for reconciliation.

Ever more, by your Spirit you move human hearts that enemies may speak to each other again, adversaries join hands, and peoples seek to meet together.

By the working of your power it comes about, O Lord, that hatred is overcome by love, revenge gives way to forgiveness, and discord is changed to mutual respect.

A NOTE ON INTINCTION: There seems to be a bit of confusion concerning Intinction, or dipping the Sacred Host into the Chalice. Whatever you have seen or been told, the <u>sole</u> authority on what happens at Mass is the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, which is quite clear about Intinction:

287. If Communion from the chalice is carried out by intinction, each communicant, holding a Communionplate under the mouth, approaches the Priest who holds a vessel with the sacred particles, with a minister standing at his side and holding the chalice. The Priest takes a host, intincts it partly in the chalice and, showing it, says, The Body and Blood of Christ. The communicant replies, Amen, receives the Sacrament in the mouth from the Priest, and then withdraws.

In other words, only the priest may intinct, not the communicant, who must then receive on the tongue.

If you are concerned about possible contamination from the chalice, especially as winter viruses are on the way, then please just receive the Sacred Host and reverence the Precious Blood as you pass by. Your Holy Communion will not be any the less for that.

Fr Bill has instructed EMHC to place their hand over the Chalice if Intinction is attempted. Please do not attempt to instinct at OLOL as you will be putting Fr Bill and our EMHCs in a difficult position, and confusing others over the practice of Intinction.
