SYRO-MALANKARA RITE MASS: Will be celebrated on Saturday at 11.00am at OLOL. We welcome Frs Johnson and Kuriakose who will be offering the Mass. The Syro-Malankara Church is, along with the Syro-Malabar Church, in full communion with Rome. Both originate in Kerala, South India. Many of our parishioners are part of one or the other Church. Each has its own distinctive Rites and Canon Law, including the Mass, which is known as the "Holy Qurbana" meaning "Holy Offering/Sacrifice", celebrated in Malayalam. Everyone is welcome.

ST GREGORY OF NAREK: Was a monk of the Maronite Church based in Lebanon, also in Communion with Rome with its own Rites and Canon Law. St Gregory is revered for his holiness, poetry, and learning and is a Doctor of the Church. His memorial falls this Thursday. At this time of continued unrest in Lebanon and the Holy Land, we pray for a lasting and just peace for all.

**ST DAVID:** We pray and thank God for the faithful of the land of St David and their descendants everywhere on their patronal saint's day this Saturday.

This is a huge benefit to the Church because we can receive an extra 25% on top of your donation from the HMRC. Thank you.
