

FR BILL WRITES: Last week, I took a short break to Paris. It was a holiday but also an opportunity to visit some of the more hidden catholic shrines and churches there. I prayed at the shrines of St Vincent de Paul (whose body rests high above the sanctuary, half way to heaven), and Ss Catherine Labouré (miraculous medal) and Louise de Marillac (SVP cofounder). Most moving, however, was the crypt housing the remains of the whole convent of martyred Carmelite nuns and others guillotined for their faith during the French Revolution. It is also the resting place of BI Frédéric Ozanam (SVP). The lovely church of St Ignatius is the resting place of several Jesuit martyrs. Right next to Sacre Coeur is the 12th Century church of St Peter, the parish church of Montmartre. It is truly beautiful and is remarkable for its architectural style that is clearly Romanesque but with some Gothic elements, making it the earliest example of the transition from one to the other. It is also the place where St Ignatius of Loyola met with his first companions to propose the Society that would become the Jesuits. In all of these places I was very impressed by the sympathetic re-orderings oozing simple elegance both in materials and lighting. Moreover, without exception, there were people praying and a palpable, reverent silence that was awe-inspiring. Coupled with some seriously good food, I had a special couple of days and I would recommend Paris (but avoiding the major sites) to anyone.
