ST IGNATIUS OF ANTIOCH: St

Ignatius became Bishop of Antioch c.69AD (Yes, that early). He was taken from there to be put to death in the Roman Colosseum. On the way, he wrote letters, copies of which still survive. We can read them or see videos about Ignatius by searching Google and/or YouTube. In these letters, Ignatus gives clear teaching on the need for unity centred on the bishop of each place; especially in the Eucharist: "Where the bishop is, there is the Church." He tells us that bishops, presbyters (priests), and deacons are already an established part of the Church. He defends Christ's true humanity and true divinity, and the pre-eminence of the church of Rome. These are, therefore, not late developments, but an essential part of the Church's teaching from its infancy. Ignatius was thrown to lions c.107, "ground like the wheat of Christ" as he put it earlier. Today, we keep his feast day on 17th October (this Thursday). Image: Hosios Loukas Monastery, Boeotia,
