

ISRAELI/PALESTINIAN CEASEFIRE

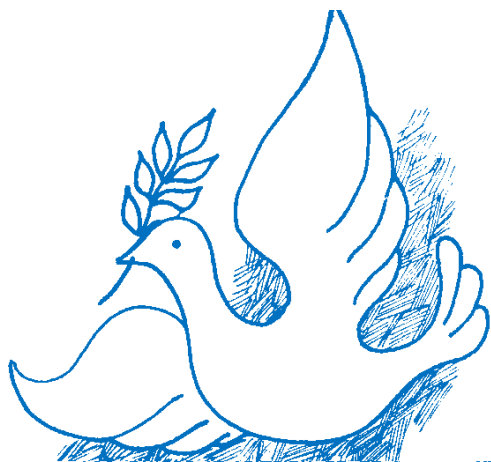
