INTERNAL CHURCH REDECORATION: We have been given the go ahead by the Diocese to repair and paint the complete interior of the church as part of our centenary plans. There will be major disruption while the work is taking place and the church will be out of action for a couple of weeks. Dates are subject to confirmation with the firm undertaking the work. We'll keep you posted.

CHURCH FAÇADE:

Unfortunately, part of the façade has fallen off. Until a full assessment can be made, we are back to using the side door to get in and out of the church. The main doors will be unlocked during Mass in case of emergency, though. Because of the situation, the church will be locked outside of Mass times. Sorry for any inconvenience, but safety is the top priority.

RESTORED CROSS: Will be "planted" on Wednesday, weather permitting.

REPAIRING OUR CHURCH

WINDOWS: The bowing of some of the windows has now been designated an urgent health and safety matter. We have been asked to cordon-off any windows concerned until repairs take place. We can repair the smaller ones without much of a problem financially. However, the larger ones will take months of work off-site and will be very expensive. There are about 6 of them. Each large window will cost about £1,600 to refurbish. We wondered if a (extended) family might like to pool together to cover the cost of a window with a dedication panel placed next to their sponsored window in memoriam or thanksgiving. Please see Fr Bill or Colin if you might be interested. We already have 3 large windows sponsored!
